

Appenzell - Engelberg

13 days / 12 nights

Appenzell in Eastern Switzerland, a most quaint and traditional region with rolling hills and painted houses. Also of interest is the Landesgemeindeplatz, the square on which the annual voting of the community takes place.

Engelberg the most popular summer and winter resort in Central Switzerland famous for its Benedictine monastery school, its glaciated mountain and fjord-like mountain lakes offering an abundance of different trails.

- Day 1 Transfer from Zurich Airport to Appenzell

- Day 2 Mount Kronberg Walk, walk on a high plateau through meadows and along a high moor

- Day 3 Hoher Kasten Walk, walking up the valley and taking the cable car to the Hoher Kasten to luxuriate in the magnificent views of the Rhein Valley.

- Day 4 A day in St. Gallen visit to the Abbey Library & Old Town.

- Day 5 Ebenalp – Schaefer Walk, descending to the pre-historic cave.

- Day 6 Transfer Day, with a visit to the medieval village and castle of Werdenberg.

- Day 7 On the way up to the waterfall valley stop for a visit at the Benedictine monastery.

- Day 8 Join a ranger on the Ristis – Brunni Walk.

- Day 9 Mt. Titlis – The Glacier & Mountain Lake, by taking 3 different cable cars. Join a farmer and taste his cheese at an alpine summer farm.

- Day 10 A day in Lucerne guided field trip.

- Day 11 Cradle of Switzerland, where the Confederates convened to confirm the everlasting League in 1291.

- Day 12 Transfer to Zurich Airport, remainder of the day on your own.

- Day 13 Shuttle to Zurich Airport
