

Madeira

10 days / 9 nights

With its reputation as the "Isle of Flowers," Madeira's rich, volcanic soil and lavedas — or carriage ways and mini-canals — offer pristine walkways that wind along its coastlines, weave through gardens and lead to the islands most scenic vistas. Meander along one of Portugal's most beautiful regions as you join local experts for a walking exploration of Madeira's capital city of Funchal, a city wedged between the sea and mountain slopes.

Day 1	Transfer from the airport to the hotel in Lisbon and visiting Lisbon.
Day 2	Transfer day by plane to Funchal, Madeira where the hotel is located.
Day 3	Walking field trip along the Levada do Norte and visiting the Calheta sugar cane mill.
Day 4	Exploring the Botanical Gardens and enjoying a walk along the Levada da Serra do Faial in Camacha. Finish the day with a toboggan run.
Day 5	Crossing the plateau Paul da Serra and enjoying a romantic walk through a wooded area.
Day 6	Learn about the Machico and have a special Portugese BBQ in a local restaurant.
Day 7	Garden of the north where you can enjoy a magnificent view of the region and walk along the Levada do Castelejo.
Day 8	Guided visit of Funchal with the gardens, the cathedral and the colourful market.
Day 9	Transfer back by plane to Lisbon and explore the city.
