Jungfraujoch

On foot and led by local experts, explore the picturesque villages and idyllic valleys of Switzerland's Bernese Oberlands, including areas that are only accessible by cog railway. Experience places where timeless traditions live on, Alpine peaks reach toward the sky and every turn in the path is rewarded with vistas of breathtaking beauty.

- Lauterbrunnen - walking in the valley with stunning views of the Bernese Alps

Itinerary

Thursday: Arrival and transfer to Wengen

Arrive at Zurich Airport for the group transfer by private coach (3 hours) to Lauterbrunnen, and from there by cogwheel train to Wengen (20 minutes). Check in at the hotel. If time permits, you will take an introduction stroll through the village. Enjoy a welcome drink before dinner.

Friday: Jungfraujoch - Top of Europe, UNESCO World Heritage

The highest railway station in Europe is located 3454 m/11'333 ft. above sea level. Visitors gain access to a high-Alpine wonderland of ice, snow and rock, which they can admire from the viewing platforms on the Aletsch Glacier or in the Ice Palace. The railway journey to the Jungfraujoch is an experience which leads through the Eiger and the Mönch. After excursion, walk from the Eigergletscher railway station. You walk a few steps back towards Kleine Scheidegg, cross the tracks of the Jungfrau Railway and hike up to the vantage point above the station. This is the beginning of the Eiger Trail, which also makes the Eiger an adventure for hikers as it actually runs along the foot of the famous Eiger North Wall. You can thus get close to the scene of heroic Alpine deeds and dramas without having any climbing experience whatsoever.

Saturday: Lauterbrunnen

Begin today's field trip by taking the cogwheel down to Lauterbrunnen and the funicular to Gruetschalp (4875 feet), and then walk to Murren (5373 feet). The Bernese Alps will appear right in front of your eyes. Continue by cable car down to the Lauterbrunnen valley. On the return, view the most impressive Truemmebach waterfalls (the only waterfalls in Europe inside a mountain).

Sunday: Berne and Departure

After breakfast transfer to Berne the capital of Switzerland and an UNESCO World Heritage Centre. Enjoy a guided city tour before transfer to Zurich Airport for departure.
