

Wengen - Bettmeralp

13 days / 12 nights

Wengen, a village without cars first mentioned in 1268. Originally it was a farming community and the first tourist arrived beginning the 19th century. The countless hiking trails are framed by the Jungfrau mountain with its breathtaking views.

Bettmeralp, another car free delightful village, situated high above the Rhone valley on a south-facing plateau with views of the Valais mountains including the Matterhorn and at the foot of one of Europe's longest glaciers, the Aletsch glacier.

- Day 1 Transfer from Zurich Airport to Lauterbrunnen and by cogwheel to Wengen.
- Day 2 The Mürren Walk where the Bernese Alps unfold right in front of your eyes.
- Day 3 The Grindelwald Valley, walk the famous Höhenweg.
- Day 4 The Beatushöhlen (caves) with beautiful drip stone formations and a field trip of Interlaken.
- Day 5 Walk from the Männlichen to the Kl. Scheidegg at the foot of the Jungfrau mountain.
- Day 6 The "Schynige Platte" and its botanical garden.
- Day 7 Transfer to Bettmeralp via the Grimsel pass. At Betten change to the cable car.
- Day 8 Walk to the neighbouring village Riederalp and up to the Villa Cassel and down to the Aletschwald (forest).
- Day 9 The Rhone Valley Walk, cable car to Betten, train to Ausserberg surrounded by vineyards.
- Day 10 A day in Zermatt.
- Day 11 The final day is spent on top of the Bettmerhorn and walk the glacier trail.
- Day 12 Transfer day, to Zurich Airport, afternoon is independent.
- Day 13 Shuttle to Zurich Airport.
